2007 European ICT Prize: Netviewer is among the 20 prize winners

Award ceremony to be held at the CeBIT with EU Commissioner Viviane Reding

Karlsruhe, 22 February 2007 - Netviewer has reached the final rounds of the ICT Grand Prize awarded by the European Union: during a tough elimination process, a jury of sixteen selected 20 ICT Prize Winners from 70 nominated companies. EU Commissioner Viviane Reding will present the three ICT Grand Prize Winners at the CeBIT in Hanover on 16 March.

Since 1995, the European Commission has been awarding the ICT Prize to particularly innovative products in the field of information and communication technology. Experts evaluate the products admitted to the competition in terms of technical achievement, innovation quota, competitive potential and job creation.

With its one2meet web collaboration solution, Netviewer was voted the ICT Prize Winner for 2007 out of 450 competitors from 30 countries. Analysts from Gartner and Frost & Sullivan are predicting that over the next few years' software for real-time collaboration via the web will develop in much the same way as e-mail and internet. Accelerating globalization of the economy and increasing environmental pollution will further this trend.

Netviewer's one2meet really comes into its own during virtual meetings of every kind: companies save time and money since travel costs are eliminated and decision-making can be speeded up considerably.
